



GUIDELINES FOR THE NHNPA GLOBAL EXCHANGE FUND

PURPOSE:

- To develop awareness of global healthcare issues and to provide for outreach to practitioners and patients outside of the NH Nurse Practitioner Association (NHNPA) members' geographic practice area.

GUIDELINES:

- \$5,000 will be set aside, annually, for the purpose of funding projects, trips, training and/or outreach.
- Individual awards will be granted, up to \$1,000/practitioner/year.
- Applicant must be a NH-licensed Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner, who is a full member in good standing of NHNPA.
- The application process will involve submission of a cover letter describing the proposed use of the funds requested. This should clearly demonstrate an outreach focus that will enrich the practice of the applicant and/or enhance the education and practice of the population s/he wishes to reach. The letter should include detailed information describing the proposed benefit and include relevant program brochures, cost breakdown, and any other pertinent information.
- The application should also include a copy of the *curriculum vitae* of the applicant.
- Determination of each award will be made at either an Executive Board or Full Board meeting of NHNPA. Those members present will constitute a quorum.
- Funds not spent during a given fiscal year (May 1st – April 30th) will revert to the NHNPA general fund.
- Award recipients are required to share their experiences with the NHNPA membership. Details of the written or oral presentation, and the mechanism of dissemination, shall be developed by the recipient, in collaboration with NHNPA's Executive Director.
